H HOW TO RUN

- 1 Process (120 minutes):**
- 2 Select Comparisons (15 min):**
 - Choose 5-8 comparable solutions
 - Include direct competitors and adjacent spaces
 - Select based on learning goals
- 3 Define Criteria (15 min):**
 - What aspects will you compare?
 - Examples: features, UX, visual design, pricing, onboarding
- 4 Analyze Each (60 min):**
 - Use consistent criteria across all
 - Take screenshots/notes
 - Document strengths and weaknesses
 - Note surprises

KEY TIP

Be systematic - use same criteria for all solutions.

- > Identify design patterns
- > Find differentiation opportunities
- > Learn from others' solutions
